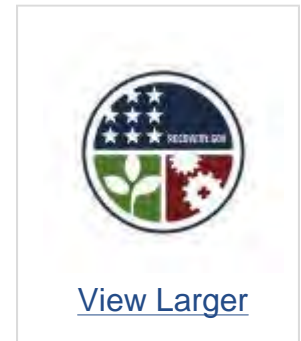

Stimulus projects to feature new emblem

President Barack Obama unveiled a new emblem Tuesday that will be used on projects funded by the economic stimulus package.

The emblem covers most of the basics of the \$787 billion package — gears representing infrastructure, a red cross representing health care, a plant representing green technology — as well as flag-like stars and Recovery.gov, the Web site that will track the progress of stimulus projects.



A White House press release said the emblem “is a symbol of President Obama’s commitment to the American people to invest their tax dollars wisely to put Americans back to work.”

Obama traveled to the **U.S. Department of Transportation** Tuesday to announce the release of \$28 billion in stimulus funds to state and local transportation authorities. This money will be used to repair and build roads and bridges.

“It’s an investment being made at an unprecedented pace,” Obama said. “Fourteen days after I signed our recovery act into law, we are seeing shovels hit the ground.”
