## Arizona transit to get \$101 million from stimulus

Arizona is line for close to \$101 million in stimulus funding for mass transit projects under the federal economic plan. That \$101 million does not include another \$17 million in transit stimulus money that will be sent to American Indian communities, several of which are based in Arizona.

The **U.S. Federal Transit Administration** is doling out \$8.4 billion in stimulus money for transit and energy projects under the \$787 billion American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. That includes \$1.1 billion for California, \$125 million for Washington, D.C., and \$1.2 billion for New York, according FTA.

The U.S. Department of Transportation also announced that Indian tribes can apply for transit funds and states and regions can put in for \$100 million in grants aimed at helping reduce emissions and energy usage.
