Arizona DOT awards \$17M in stimulus contracts

The Arizona Department of Transportation awarded more than \$17 million in contracts Friday for road projects funded by the federal stimulus package known as the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

The largest contract awarded was for widening U.S. 95 in Yuma County. The nearly \$9 million project was awarded to Royden Construction Co. of Phoenix.

Other contracts awarded Friday:

- Widening of Grand Avenue between 83rd and 99th Avenue; awarded to Pulice Construction Co., Phoenix; \$6.5 million
- Pavement treatment near Interstate 10 and State Route 82 in southeastern Arizona; awarded to Southwest Slurry Seal Inc., Phoenix; \$942,000
- Pavement treatment on U.S. 95 in Yuma County; awarded to Cactus Transport Inc., Tolleson; \$398,000
- Pavement treatment on U.S. 60 in Maricopa County; awarded to Southwest Slurry Seal Inc., Phoenix; \$291,000
- Fence replacement along State Route 73 in Gila County; awarded to D&O Contractors Inc., Glendale; \$257,000
- Fence replacement along I-40 in Mohave County; awarded to Abbco Sign Group Inc., Peoria; \$163,000
