Arizona DOT awards \$27M in stimulus contracts

The Arizona Department of Transportation awarded six contracts this week totaling about \$27 million for highway projects funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment act. The largest is a \$10.4 million interchange reconstruction in Pima County. Two of the projects are in Maricopa County.

Project: Interchange reconstruction, Interstate 10 from Cienega Creek to Marsh Station, Pima County

Amount: \$10.4 million

Company: Pulice Construction Inc., Phoenix

Project: Road widening, State Route 85 from I-10 to Southern Avenue, Maricopa County

Amount: \$9.2 million

Company: Southwest Asphalt Paving, Dickinson, N.D.

Project: Repaving U.S. 95 from Peligro to Clarks, La Paz County

Amount: \$6.8 million

Company: Bison Contracting Co. Inc., Phoenix

Project: Drainage improvement on U.S. 191 near Coronado Trail, Greenlee County

Amount: \$320,555

Company: D&O Contractors Inc., Glendale

Project: Fence replacement on I-8 from U.S. 95 to Araby Road, Yuma County

Amount: \$254,502

Company: Sun State Builders Inc., Tempe

Project: Fence replacement on I-10 from Vail Road to the county line, Pima County

Amount: \$160,655
