



## ADOT to host workshops focusing on future road, transportation needs

The Arizona Department of Transportation is hosting several workshops across the state that focus on the state's future needs for roads and transit services.

According to information from ADOT, community residents statewide are invited to help shape the future of transportation of Arizona by participating in the workshops. The workshops will give residents the chance to review and comment on possible future transportation ideas that plan for growth, community development and economic patterns.

ADOT began the Statewide Transportation Study earlier this year and focuses on the year 2050. The study is broken into four regional sections of the state -- northern, western, central and eastern.

The Flagstaff meeting will be Nov. 12 from 3:30 to 7:30 p.m. at the High Country Conference Center, 201 W. Butler Ave.

Workshops are also planned for Globe, Show Low, Coolidge, Bullhead City, Prescott, Lake Havasu City, Sierra Vista, Holbrook, Nogales, Yuma and Window Rock.
