

ADOT asking public for input on state plan

SIERRA VISTA — The Arizona Department of Transportation is inviting local residents to help shape the future of transportation in Arizona by participating in a community workshop in Sierra Vista on Nov. 18.

The workshop will be held twice that day at the Windemere Hotel, 2047 S. Highway 92. The first session will run from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. and the second session will run from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. ADOT began the Statewide Transportation Planning Study in early 2008 to focus on a long-range vision of transportation needs in Arizona.

This study is also known as “Building a Quality Arizona” and focuses on the year 2050. The study is composed of four Regional Framework Studies: Northern, Western, Central and Eastern Arizona. Each Regional Framework Study looks at ways to plan for growth, understand community development and economic patterns, and be prepared for future transportation needs.
